



GREENWICH HOUSE POTTERY INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

APPLICATION DEADLINE FOR SUMMER: MAY 1

DESCRIPTION:

The Internship Program offers high school, college and graduate students a short-term work experience in the Pottery's studio or arts administration. Through hands-on experience, interns are exposed to the day-to-day activities of a thriving community arts organization, while given the opportunity to explore their own work in a studio environment. Summer Interns assist with a variety of special projects ranging in scope from studio-oriented tasks, including kiln firing and mixing clay, to facility repairs such as painting, to administrative projects. Interns have studio access during open studio time, all stocked materials, and free firings. Summer Interns work directly with the Studio Manager or administrative staff, depending upon the internship requested.

Our facilities include professional equipment and materials, including 2 gas kilns, 4 electric kilns, 2 large format slab rollers, 2 clay mixers, 3 clay extruders, 4 clay bodies, and an extensive inventory of glazes and chemicals.

ELIGIBILITY:

The Summer Intern Program is open to all United States residents over 18 who are enrolled in part-time or full-time academic study. Applicants should demonstrate motivation in their work, an ability to work well in a group environment, and a strong desire to expand their knowledge of the ceramic medium. Some studio experience is strongly preferred for those seeking internships in the studio.

DURATION:

Fall, Winter & Spring Internships duration and applications ongoing.
Summer Internships are 1 or 2 months (July & August) applications due May 1.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE: (SUMMER DEADLINE MAY 1)

APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- Resume
- 10 images labeled with descriptions (materials, size, date)
- A letter of interest indicating the purpose for which the internship is requested. Tell about your background and your artistic ambitions. What do you hope to gain from an internship at Greenwich House Pottery?
- A list of 2 professional or academic references with emails.
