# REGISTRATION

Classes are designed for individuals 18 years and older.

## Payments

Greenwich House accepts cash, checks and credit cards. There is a returned check fee of \$35.

## Absence

There is no refund, make-up class or credit for student absence. If a teacher is absent, a make-up lesson or substitute teacher will be arranged.

## Financial Aid

The Pottery offers financial aid. Applications (available at [greenwichhouse.org/pottery/financial-aid](http://greenwichhouse.org/pottery/financial-aid)) must be submitted every term; applications are due by the following deadlines:

Winter: November 25, 2019  
Spring: February 25, 2020  
Summer: June 5, 2020

## Refunds, Reimbursement & Transfers

All requests for refunds must be made in writing. For a 100% refund, requests must be received one week prior to the first day of class. Written requests received less than a week and at least one day prior to the first class will receive a 75% refund. Written requests received at least one day prior to the second class will receive a 50% refund. After the second day of class no refunds will be issued. Refunds are subject to a \$25 administration fee. Refunds for workshops and events must be received three weeks prior to the event.

Students enrolled in 12-week or 11-week classes are permitted to transfer to another class within the same term up to the second week of class provided there is an available seat. Students enrolled in six-week classes are permitted to transfer to another six-week class within the same session, up to the second week of class, subject to instructor approval and provided there is an available seat. Transfers to alternate terms or sessions are subject to refund and registration policies. Visit our website for complete guidelines.

## Incentives

**Refer a Friend:** Returning students who get a friend (who has not previously taken classes at the Pottery) to sign up for a class will receive a \$50 firing credit; as an added bonus, your friend will receive a \$25 firing credit.

**The Regular:** Sign up for fall, winter and spring full term classes, or any three full term classes, all at once and receive a \$100 firing credit.

**The Devotee:** Sign up for two full term classes in one term and receive a \$50 firing credit.

## Facilities

The Pottery features two handbuilding studios, two wheel-throwing studios, a mold-making and slip-casting studio, 28 potter's wheels, two gas kilns, five electric kilns, two slab rollers, one extruder, one clay mixer, three de-airing pug mills and a spray booth. Eight clay bodies are available: porcelain casting slip, sculpture paperclay, porcelain paperclay, white stoneware, throwing stoneware, sculpture stoneware, red earthenware and 25-pound bags of porcelain. GHP has a large selection of high and low temperature glazes, slips and washes and offers low-, mid- and high-temperature firings.

## Open Studio

Open Studio is an exclusive benefit for currently enrolled students. On occasion, Open Studio may be canceled for special classes, projects or functions. Every effort will be made to give prior notice before cancellations.

## Firing Policy

Firing charges are 6 cents per cubic inch for two firings, or 3 cents per cubic inch for a single fire. There is a \$1 minimum charge on all pieces, including single-fired work. GHP offers incremental discounts for individual pieces that cost over \$10 to fire.

For pieces over \$10: Receive a 10% discount of the amount in excess of \$10.

For pieces over \$50: Receive a 25% discount of the amount in excess of \$10.

For pieces over \$100: Receive a 35% discount of the amount in excess of \$50.
