GHP offers a ceramics program for every level of practice including wheel-throwing, handbuilding and slip-casting. For in-person classes, tuition includes clay and glaze. Students taking classes online may purchase clay, drop-off work for firing and may come into the studio for glazing. All firing fees are paid separately.

Handbuilding and wheel-throwing

classes take place in the morning, afternoon and evening. Registration is for 1.5 hours of class instruction accompanied by 2.5 hours of open studio hours within a 4-hour block.

REGISTRATION

Register online, by mail or in-person. Registration is available online at www. greenwichhouse.org/pottery/classes Payment is due at time of registration. Classes are designed for individuals 18 years and older.

Payments Greenwich House accepts cash, checks and credit cards. There is a returned check fee of \$50.

Make-up Classes The Pottery is not responsible for issuing reimbursements or providing make-up classes for those missed due to illness, substitute teachers, or other events beyond our control. We do not prorate for missed classes. Attending an alternate class is not permitted.

*During weather emergencies, GHP closes in accordance with the NYC public school system, as broadcast on the radio and local TV news. Emergency closures are announced via email and can be retrieved on the phone at 212-242-4106 ext. 5.

CLASS CANCELLATION DUE TO COVID: Due to these extraordinary times, in the event that the Pottery must close in accordance with another city-mandated shutdown of Phase 4 operations due to COVID-19, inperson classes will immediately be moved online and the price difference (between in-person vs. online) for remaining classes will be provided as a firing credit or refund. If the course has not yet begun (C/D section classes) refunds will be provided in full to students who do not wish to proceed online. Students enrolled in cancelled studio sessions will receive a refund for those sessions.

REFUNDS FOR IN-PERSON CLASSES: All requests for refunds for classes must be made in writing. All refunds are subject to a \$50 administration fee. For a 100% refund, requests must be received one week prior to the first day of class. Written requests received less than a week and at least one day prior to the first class will receive a 50% refund. After the first day of class no refunds will be issued.

REFUNDS FOR ONLINE CLASSES: Online courses are not eligible for a refund or transfer once registration has been processed..

TRANSFERS: Students enrolled in six-week in-person classes are permitted to transfer to another six-week class within the same session, up to the second week of class, subject to instructor approval and provided there is an available seat. Transfers to alternate terms or sessions are subject to refund and registration policies. Visit our website for complete guidelines.

Financial Aid The Pottery offers financial aid. Applications (available at www. greenwichhouse.org/pottery/financial-aid) must be submitted every term; applications are due by the following deadlines:

Fall: September 4, 2020 Winter: November 23, 2020 Spring: February 23, 2021 Summer: June 4, 2021

Facilities The Pottery features two handbuilding studios, two wheel-throwing studios, a mold-making and slip-casting studio, 28 potter's wheels, two gas kilns, five electric kilns, two slab rollers, one extruder, one clay mixer, three de-airing pug mills and a spray booth. Six clay bodies are available this term: porcelain casting slip, white stoneware, throwing stoneware, sculpture stoneware, red earthenware and 25-pound bags of porcelain. GHP has a large selection of high and low temperature glazes, slips and washes and offers low, mid- and high-temperature firings.

Firing Policy Firing charges are 3 cents per cubic inch for a single fire. There is a \$1 minimum charge on all pieces. GHP offers incremental discounts for individual pieces that cost over \$10 to fire.

For pieces over \$10: Receive a 10% discount of the amount in excess of \$10. For pieces over \$50: Receive a 25% discount of the amount in excess of \$10. For pieces over \$100: Receive a 35% discount of the amount in excess of \$50.

Studio Sessions To work in the Pottery studios outside of your registered class time, you must register for a studio session. You must be an enrolled students (online or in-person) to register for a studio session and it must be within the duration of the class for which you have enrolled. Studio reservations are specific to the room you select. (For example, if you register for a wheel studio session, you must work in the wheel room you are assigned, you may not move to a handbuilding studio.) Available times and studios are available on the class registration page by searching the "Fall 2020" term for "Studio Sessions." Studio sessions will take place Friday nights, Saturday afternoons, and Sunday morning and afternoon.

Each studio session is a 4-hour block of time, and costs \$25 per block. Studio sessions are limited to a maximum of 6 students in each studio.
